We are a confidential, free service that's available in every school in Nova Scotia. As a Community Outreach Worker, I do three main things:

- 1 My team and I help build good relationships between families, schools and the community.
- **2 We help parents and families find the programs, resources, and support that they need**. Some examples are: recreation programs for kids and funding for these programs, help paying for eyeglasses and other important items, and help applying for programs that can help families pay their bills.
- **3.** We offer group programming for parents and for students. Some examples are Handle with Care, Incredible Years Parenting Program and Home Alone.

A good way to sum up what I do is: My job is to help make sure that your child has everything they need to succeed – from home, to school, and back again.
